## **Community Involvement in Neighbourhood Planning**









A local parish or town council is able to prepare a Neighbourhood Plan or Order for their area.

Once a Neighbourhood Plan or Order has been through consultation, examination and is agreed by a local referendum, it becomes part of the Development Plan and the policies contained within them are then used in the determination of planning applications.

Consultation and community engagement takes place throughout the preparation of a Neighbourhood plan/order

Most of these activities are carried out by the Town or Parish Councils

Lewes District Council carries out some key formal consultations and is responsible for holding the referendum

- A **Neighbourhood Plan** is a planning document which establishes general policies for development and use of land in a neighbourhood, including the location of new homes, and what they should look like
- A Neighbourhood Development Order means that town and parish councils can grant permission for certain types of development without the need for people to apply to Lewes District Council

Town and Parish Councils will use various methods to consult the community as they prepare Neighbourhood Plans or Orders
