## BYELAWS

for the prevention of danger, obstruction or annoyance to persons bathing in the sea or using the sea shore made by the Council of the County Borough of Eastbourne in pursuance of Section 76 of the Public Health Act, 1961

- 1. These Byelaws shall apply to the sea shore situated within the County Borough of Eastbourne between Langney Point and Groyne No. 1 situate at Holywell, 200 yards south-west of the end of the Western Parade and therefrom for a distance seaward of 500 yards from low water mark of ordinary spring tides.
- 2. In these Byelaws, "navigator" means the person who, whether as owner or otherwise, has the charge or control of a pleasure boat and includes a person who, being present, is entitled to give orders to the person having charge or control.
- 3. No person, being the navigator of a pleasure ground, shall cause or suffer such vessel to be driven or sailed in a dangerous manner or without due care and attention or without reasonable consideration for other persons.
- 4. No person, being the navigator of a pleasure boat propelled by an internal combustion engine, shall use the pleasure boat unless the engine is fitted with a silencer suitable and sufficient for reducing as far as may be reasonable the noise caused by the escape of the exhaust gases from the engine.
- 5. Any person offending against any of the foregoing byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding five pounds.
- 6. Nothing contained in any of the foregoing byelaws shall be deemed to be or shall operate as a grant by or on behalf of the Crown as owner of the seabed below low water mark of any estate or interest in or right over such seabed, or any part thereof, nor shall anything contained in or done under any of the provisions of the foregoing byelaws in any respect prejudice or injuriously affect the rights and interests of the Crown in such seabed, or prevent the exercise of any public rights or prejudice or

injuriously affect any right, power or privilege legally exercisable in, over and in respect of the seabed.
