BYELAWS RELATING TO PROMENADES

Made by Eastbourne Borough Council under Section 83 of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907 with respect to promenades in the Borough.

The byelaws made by **EASTBOURNE BOROUGH COUNCIL** on 19th April 1995 and confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Home Department on 21st July 1995 are hereby amended as follows:-

Byelaw 12(3)

In byelaw 12(3) the definition of "model aircraft" is amended to read as follows:-

"model aircraft" means an aircraft which weighs not more than 7 kilograms without its fuel;

Byelaw 13

In byelaw 13, the words "Groyne 60" are amended to read "Groyne 56".

Schedule

The Schedule is amended as follows:-

(1) In (b) after "also known as" insert the words:

"Madeira Walk" or

(2) At the end of the Schedule insert the following:

(f) All interconnecting access drives, ramps, staircases and planted areas linking between King Edward's Parade, Middle Parade and Western Parade.

(g) The promenade and access road at Fisherman's Green Car Park, including the connecting path from Royal Parade, between the tennis courts.

(h) The timber ramp at groyne 64.

- (i) Eastern Parade from groyne 64 opposite Channel View Road to the end of the Parade opposite Atlantic Drive, including the promenade leading from Royal Parade between Fort Fun and Monarch House and the promenade leading from Royal Parade between Fort Fun and Fort Fun Car Park.
