ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1972

The Eastbourne Borough Council pursuant to arrangements made under Section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the East Sussex County Council and in exercise of those powers under Section 31 of the Road Traffic Act 1972 hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit a dog to be on a designated road as set out in the schedule below without a dog being on a lead.
2. Nothing in this Order shall apply to dogs proved to be kept for driving or tending sheep or cattle in the course of a trade or business or to have been at the material time in use under proper control for sporting purposes.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 1st May 1987 and will be cited as "The Eastbourne Borough Council (Control of Dogs on Roads) Traffic Order 1987".

KING EDWARD'S PARADE	From its junction with Silverdale Road to Grand Parade.
GRAND PARADE	The whole length.
MARINE PARADE	The whole length.
ROYAL PARADE	From Marine Parade to its junction with Beach Road.
