1.	What method do you use for weed control?	Foam Stream /Vinegar based / mechanical
2.	Do you use Chemicals?	Limited use of Glyphosate for specific issues such as knot weed.
3.	If you use chemicals is the council looking to using a more environmentally friendly method?	Yes – We are primarily pesticide free.
4.	Does the council carry out weed control duties in-house or is this contracted out?	Contracted out. However weed control of streets paths and highways comes under East Sussex County Council (ESCC) and not LDC.
5.	(If contracted out) who is the contractor responsible for street cleansing duties?	Street cleansing duties are carried out in-house. Weed control carried out by ESCC.
