

Matter 1

- 1.1 **Paragraph 2.5** of the **Changes to Policy Map** document refers to the Proposed Submission version of the Employment Land Local Plan (ELLP) being published in *October 2014*.
- 1.2 This should read: 'November 2014.'

Matter 2

- 2.1 **Paragraph 4.3** of the Proposals Map document explains the colour coding that is used within the three sets of maps that are provided within the document, This includes reference to the:
 - blue site boundary line defined as representing 'the new or amended policies and designations that have changed as a result of changes to the **Town Centre Local Plan**'.
- 2.2 **Paragraph 4.5** summarises the details contained within the three sets of maps provided as including:
 - those showing new policies and designations contained in the *Town Centre Local Plan (TCLP)*
- 2.3 We assume the references to the TCLP should be to the 'Employment Land Local Plan.'

Matter 3

- 3.1 **Map No. 7 at Appendix A** of the document indicates Sites 4, 6 and 7 as the land that is **proposed to be** allocated through ELLP Policy EL4.
- 3.2 The site boundaries and plan details however do not reflect:
 - The land that is actually available to be development as part of **Site 6**, i.e. the land that was in SHL's ownership but that has now been sold to other parties for the promotion of Class B1 development.
 - The land that is available for the development of **Site 4**, with (1) the potential development of this site also being restricted to Class B1a office use only subject to the ELLP consultation and examination

process and (2) a preference for the site to be developed for a mix of uses, including additional commercial space as an extension of the Waterfront tourist and leisure destination.

These objectives for Site 4 are consistent with the setting and existing context of the Site, Policy C14 of the adopted Eastbourne Core Strategy Local Plan, the adopted Sovereign Harbour SPD, and the now approved outline planning permission ref. 131002 as granted by EBC dated 2 December 2014.

- The land that is potentially available for B1 development within **Site 7** being restricted to **Site 7a only**, and this also being subject to the outcome of the ELLP consultation process. **Site 7b** is set aside for a new public open space and **Site 7c** for new residential development.
- The potential development of Site 7a is also further restricted to Class B1a office space only. This also accords with the adopted Sovereign Harbour SPD February 2013, and the details of the approved outline planning permission ref. 131002 and the linked s106 agreement to that permission.
- The possible further restriction of land that may potentially be available for development on Site 7a for B1a development, if the new community hall building for the Harbour that forms part of outline planning permission ref. 131002 is ultimately to be built on Site 7a, i.e. on land adjacent to the existing medical centre.
- 3.3 EBC is aware of these facts following their review of the site details that form part of the outline permission.
 Paragraphs 4.45 and 4.46 of the Proposed Submission Draft ELLP also acknowledges that Site 7a only is available for development within Site 7 for potential B1a space.
- 3.4 Copies of the site boundaries for Sites 4, 6 and 7a with the land that is set aside within Site 7a for the possible community hall building are however provided here for reference (**Annex A**).
- 3.45 Appendix B of the document additionally provides a draft update of the full Proposals Map and the Town centre Inset Plan. The former of these again indicates the incorrect site areas for Sites 6 and 7(a) and does not clearly indicate Site 4; instead it appears to indicate Site 5 of the Harbour for employment use. The colours used within the Inset Plan are also unclear and confusing.
- 3.5 The site details must therefore be corrected and the plans at Appendix B made clearer.

- 3.6 Notwithstanding the correct site details for the Sovereign Harbour sites, the <u>proposed allocation of Sites 4</u>

 <u>and 7a</u> for the strict provision of Class B1a space <u>should be deleted from the draft ELLP</u> for the reasons set out within SHL's additional objections to the ELLP, i.e:
 - Sites 4 and 7a are not required to meet the Borough's needs for new office floorspace;
 - they do not represent a sustainable development option for Eastbourne Borough or the Sovereign Harbour neighbourhood; and
 - proposed Policy EL4 accordingly does not comply with the NPPF.

Summary and Required Changes


