

Variation of a club premises certificate

Where a Club wishes to amend the Club Premises Certificate, the Act allows, in most cases, for an application to vary to be made rather than requiring an application for a new club premises certificate, including:

- varying the hours during which a licensable activity is permitted;
- · adding or removing licensable activities;
- · amending, adding or removing conditions within a licence; and
- altering any aspect of the layout of the premises which is shown on the plan.

A variation cannot be used to vary a certificate so as to:

- extend a time-limited certificate; or to
- transfer the certificate from one premises to another.

For the application process see the guidance notes issued for a new Club Premises Certificate.

Notes for Guidance

Checklist:

- 1. You do not have to pay a fee if the only purpose of the variation for which you are applying is to avoid becoming liable for the late night levy.
- 2. Describe the premises, for example the type of premises it is, its general situation and layout and any other information which would be relevant to the licensing objectives. Where your application includes off-supplies of alcohol and you intend to provide a place for people to consume these off-supplies, please include a description of where this will be and its proximity to the premises.
- 3. In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:
 - Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.

- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;

- any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
- o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
- 4. Where taking place in a building or other structure please tick as appropriate (indoors may include a tent).
- 5. Please state type of activity to be authorised, if not already stated, and give relevant further details, for example (but not exclusively) whether or not music will be amplified or unamplified.
- 6. For example (but not exclusively) where the activity will go on for an extra hour during summer months.

Notes on completing the form:

- 1. Insert the full name of the club that is making the application as detailed in the application itself.
- 2. Insert the full name of the club and the full address for which the application is being made.
- 3. List all the proposed licensable activities as detailed on the application and the hours of those activities.
- 4. 'Notice Posted': insert the date 28 consecutive days after the application was given to the Licensing Authority.

Displaying the notice on the premises

You must, for a period of no less than 28 consecutive days starting on the day after the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority, display a notice which is of a size equal or larger than A4, of a pale blue colour, printed legibly in black in or typed in black in a font of a size equal to or larger than 16 in all cases, prominently at or on the premises to which the application relates where it can be conveniently read from the exterior of the premises. In the case of a premises covering an area of more than fifty metres square, a further notice in the same form and subje3ct to the same requirements must be placed every fifty metres along the external perimeter of the premises abutting any highway.

In the local press

You must publish a notice in a local newspaper, in a local newsletter circular or similar document circulating in the vicinity of the premises on at least one occasion during the period of ten working days starting on the day after the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority.
