Amendment to designated neighbourhood area

I am writing to inform you that the South Downs National Park Authority and Lewes District Council have agreed to amend the designated neighbourhood area for Ditchling. The original extent of the area was confirmed in writing by the Local Planning Authorities on 17 June 2013.

The effect of the amendment is that the neighbourhood area will now include the parishes of Streat and Westmeston. We kindly request this letter is shared with Streat Parish Meeting and Westmeston Parish Council.

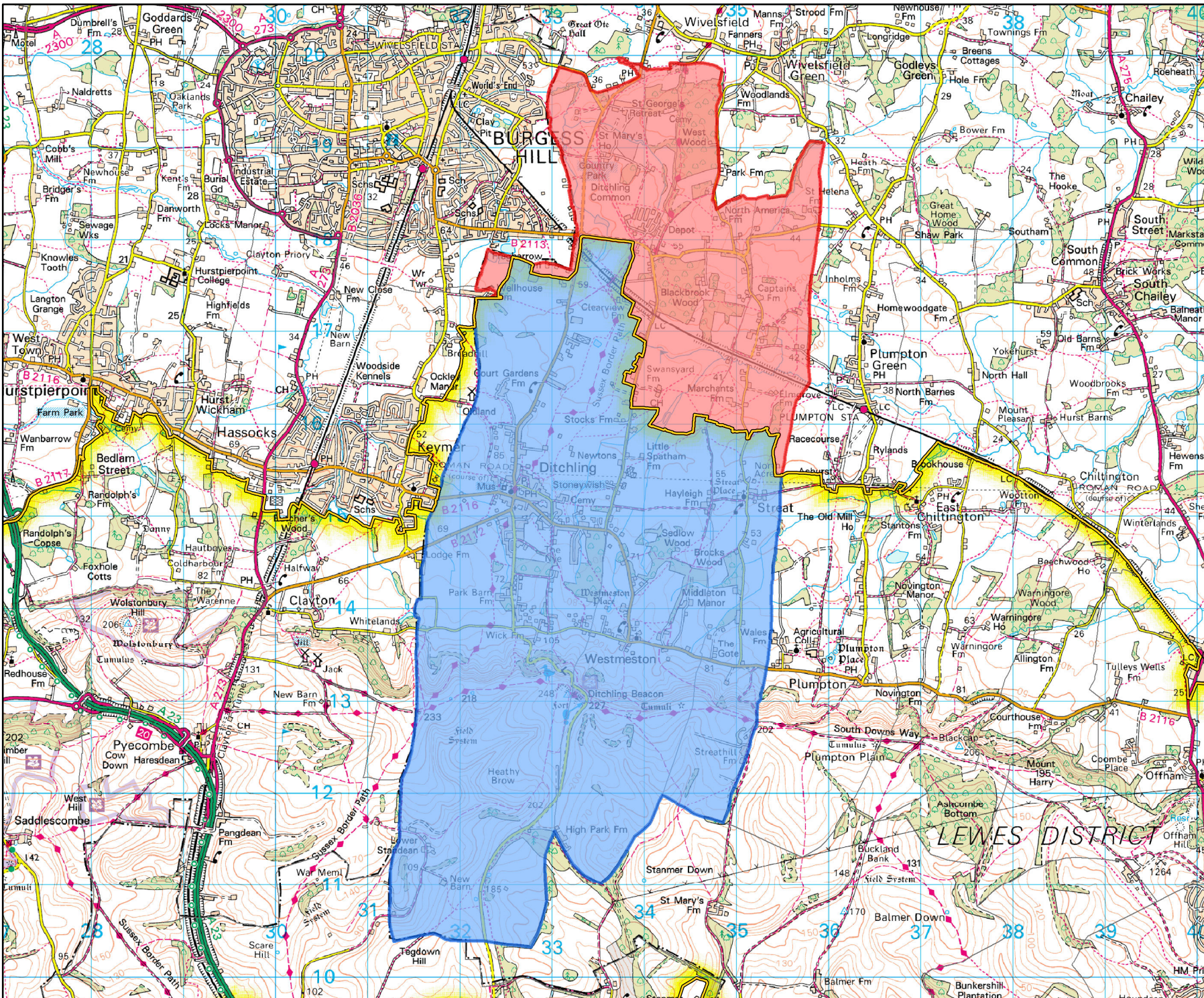
