What Does it Do?

The EBCG controls and runs the towns security radio network with radio handsets in over 120 stores and businesses throughout the town, all members of the Eastbourne Business Crime Group are linked via the SafteyNet radio system to Arndale Security and Police.

A free radio handset is supplied as part of the EBCG membership. It also has an exclusion scheme for persistent offenders, which bans them from entering all members' premises in the town. Offenders photographs and profiles for the day and night time economy are circulated via the new innovative EBCG intranet site, you and your staff can have access to this from your home or business computer. This site also allows you to send incident reports to the scheme manager which are then used for exclusions.

What is the Eastbourne Business Crime Group (EBCG)?

The Eastbourne Business Crime Group (EBCG) which has been awarded with the Safer Business **Award** from the Association of Business Crime Partnerships. The scheme is a partnership between the local business community, Eastbourne Borough Council and Sussex Police. The group was formed in April 2003 and now boasts over 180 members from both the day and night time economies, including retailers, licensee's education services. security companies, Eastbourne Railway Station and Taxi companies.

The Eastbourne Business Crime Group has its own management structure; with elected Chairpersons and a written constitution.

It has a Data Protection registration and Professional Indemnity insurance cover and an Information Sharing Agreement with Sussex Police.
