

REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

NOTICE OF CONCLUSION

Lewes District Council has completed a review of polling districts and polling places as required by the Representation of the People Act 1983 (as amended) for use at both local and national elections.

The full council approved proposals for the polling districts and polling places on 20th November 2023.

Extract of the council minutes:

Minutes:

Councillor Collier moved and Councillor MacCleary seconded the recommendations of the Head of Elections and Local Land Charges to approve the arrangements in respect of polling districts and polling places in the District of Lewes.

It was recognised that this was part of a regular review of polling arrangements. Councillor Collier in moving the report extended his thanks to Tracey Pannett (Head of Elections and Local Land Charges) and her team for carrying out the consultation.

The recommendations were put to a vote and carried unanimously.

RESOLVED:

- (1) That the Acting Returning Officer's proposals as set out in the report be approved; and
- (2) That the Head of Elections and Local Land Charges, on behalf of the Returning Officer and Electoral Registration Officer, be authorised to implement the Council's decisions in respect of the review.

The polling arrangements will come into force from 1 December 2023 on the alteration of the register.
