




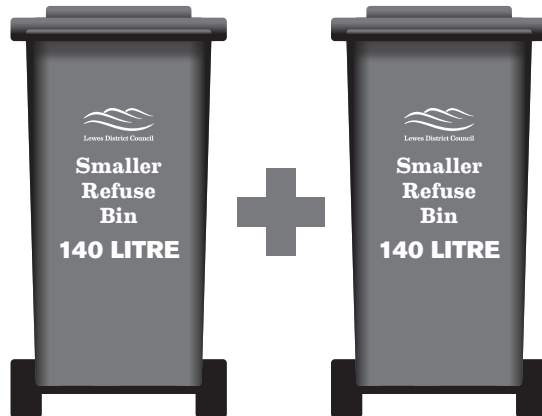
# LDC Wheeled Bin Criteria for Refuse Bins

Bin Colour: Grey body and lid

<b>Standard 240L Refuse Bin</b>	<b>Smaller “tall and thin” 140L Refuse Bin</b>	<b>175L Gull/animal proof bag Bag Colour: Green</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Suitable for a household of 5 or more</li> <li>· Suitable for small groups of flats</li> <li>· Size: H106cm x W57.5cm x D73cm</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Suitable for a household up to 5 people</li> <li>· Suitable where space is limited to store a standard 240L refuse bin</li> <li>· Size: H106cm x W48cm x D55cm</li> </ul> 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· For those with no space to store a bin</li> <li>· Assessed on a case-by-case basis by the waste team</li> <li>· Refuse is placed in your own refuse sacks / bags which are then placed inside the gull/ animal proof bag</li> <li>· Size: H90cm x W44cm x D44cm</li> </ul> 

## Additional Refuse Bin

- For a household of 10 people or more
- For a household with medical needs (non-infectious waste)
- For a group of flats or a registered HMO
- An additional bin can either a 240L or a 140L size
- Maximum of 2 refuse bins per household (unless approved by the waste team)
