2. The probability of fluvial and coastal flooding is divided into the following categories:

Flood Zone 1- Land having a less than 0.1% annual probability of river or coastal flooding (1 in 1,000 chance each year).

Flood Zone 2- Land having between a 1% and 0.1% annual probability of river flooding (between 1 in 100 and 1 in 1,000 chance each year), or between a 0.5% and 0.1% annual probability of coastal flooding (between a 1 in 200 and 1 in 1,000 chance each year).

Flood Zone 3A- Land either having a 1% or greater annual probability of river flooding (<1 in 100 chance), or having a 0.5% or greater annual probability of coastal flooding (<1 in 200 chance).

The Flood Zones shown on this figure do not take account of the possible impacts of climate change and consequent changes in the future probability of flooding. They also ignore the effect of any flood defences.
