	It was noted that SEILL referral numbers have started to increase as the C19 lockdown has started to lift.		
	Referrals for Q1 this year compared to 2019 show that there had been an increase in referrals for support with Council Tax and Housing Benefit applications, debt management and social isolation. This may indicate the effect that COVID has had on our client base.
